At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for an alteration in the County Road leading from James Ewings to London, commencing on the N.E. side of John Wilsons at the cross roads thence to run along the Road, where it is now traileed past his house, to the corner of James Wilsons pasture fence, & thence along his fence, to the S.W. corner, & thence to the crossing of Little Darby Creek near Wm Bradleys & thence to run the nearest and best Road to intersect the London Road, leading from Little Darby bridge to London, at the farm formerly owned by James Heath

Whereupon Thos Kellgou, Abijah Gary, & Paul Decker brewers and Henry Warner Surveyor, be appointed to view Survey and Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law: to Meet at John Wilsons on the 29th inst Provided the petitioner John Wilson shall pay all expenses =

132+5 June 1st No objections being presented the following alteration is ordered to be recorded, and opened according to law: commencing on the N.E. side of John Wilsons farm, where the Road leading from James Ewings to London, crosses the Road leading from Isaac Bultons Mill to Mechanicsburg, running from thence S 35 N. 57 E. 1/2 pole, thence S 71 N. 71 E. 1/2 pole, thence S 26 N. passing through the said John Wilsons lane, 50 pole, to the S.E. corner of James Wilsons pasture fence, thence with said fence, S 45 N. 148 pole to the first Mile tree; same course, passing the S.W. corner of said pasture 19 pole to the S.W. corner of James Wilsons lane, thence S 65 N. 301 pole to 2^d Mile tree; thence S 55 N. 187 pole, crossing Little Darby at 22 pole and passing through the lane of the farm where Wm Bradley now lives, thence S 46 N. 133 pole to 3^d Mile tree; same course 238 pole, thence S 40 N. 82 pole to 4th Mile tree; intersecting the Road leading from London to Millford in front of James Heaths House; and that the old way be vacated.

Britts Survey S 38 E. thence on the best Road to John C. Robinsons mill;

Whereupon James Rayburn, James Carr, & Thos Nthey brewers and Henry Warner Surveyor, be appointed to Meet at Lafayette on the 25th inst and proceed to view Survey and Make Report of said Road to the next Meeting of the board
