At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view & survey of a Road as follows to wit: Beginning at or near John Thomas in Deer Creek Township running to Benj Mams, thence to Lambert Baileys & thence to intersect the Road leading from Lancaster to Passedah at or near the Cropping of Spring fork -

Whereupon Shneur Mellan, Joseph C. Beer, and Richard Baldwin, Viewers and Henry Warner, Surveyor, were appointed to Meet at John Thomas on the 13th this inst. to Run Survey & Mark Said Road & Make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law -

1836 March 8th No Objections being Made the following Return is ordered to be recorded and opened according to law to wit: Commencing at a point in a road called McColly's Road North East and near John Thomas House at which said point there is marked a bur Oak which stands on the North side of said Road and in the edge of a small Run, also marked a bur Oak & large Elm on the South side of said Road & Run thence N 20 E. 320 poles to 1st mile tree Cropping the Columbus & Mechanick Road, at 160 poles, same course 100 poles, thence S 10 W. 120 poles passing 3 poles west of Benj Mams Stable, thence N 22 E. 92 poles to 2nd mile tree 2 poles West of Lambert Baileys house, same course 42 poles thence S 35 E. 125 poles thence N 60 E. 141 poles intersecting the Road leading from Lancaster to Millford where the said Road crosses the Spring fork of Little Darby Making a total distance of two Miles 30 1/2 poles
