

London 1st September 1817

The Commissioners Met Present Joshua Ewing
Benton Blizard and Plewid. A petition was presented from William Saffin
praying to alter the State Road running through his land. Petition granted. Viewers
John McSanaid, Thomas Luyorn and John Powers, to Meet on the first Monday
in Oct next at said Saffin

5 Same Meeting the following was ordered to be recorded viz. Beginning at
a stake near where said road crosses John Ashbaugh's land. Thence N 1° 30' W 318 poles
intersecting the road leading from Sagers Mill to the Bridge across per creek near
Thomas Luyorn about 90 poles S. E. of the first Mile Tree; This is an alteration
of the road from Sagers Mill to London

At the same Meeting the following alteration of the Chellicothe Road from
John Taylor to the East road leading from Northington to Urbana; and also
the New Road from the East road, to Sagers Mill, was ordered to be recorded =

Beginning of the alteration of the Chellicothe Road is a large Red Oak, near
the lower side of John Taylor's improvement. Thence N 6° W. 132 poles N 30° W 20 poles
N 19° W. 114 poles N 38° W. 214 poles Marked 1st Mile N 25° W. 210 poles intersecting the
East road, at a bur Oak.

New Road begining where the Chellicothe Road intersects the
East road. Thence N 25° W 234 poles intersecting the London Road about 100 poles
from Sagers Mill =

5-132 At the same Meeting it was ordered that the following be established and
Recorded as a public Road = Beginning at Sagers Mill Thence S 21° W. 49 poles S 38°
W. 271 poles S 44° W. 26 poles S 34° W. 2596 poles West 44 poles S 34° W. 1050 poles intersecting
the State Road from Thomas Luyorn to Sarah Mitchel at a small bur Oak 25
poles from two Mile Tree =

At the same Meeting the following alteration of the above road
was established and ordered to be recorded viz. Beginning where said road crosses
the Urbana Road. Thence West 44 poles Thence South 63 poles intersecting the above
Road again

At the same Meeting the following alteration of the State Road from Columbus
to Springfield was established and ordered to be recorded viz. Beginning at
the bottom of George Sams running S 47° W. to the East bank of Little Dryby
49 poles. Thence from the East bank N 47° W. to the Top of the hill west of Samuel
Sexton's Farm at the place where the present road descends said hill 150 poles
Thence N 75° W. to Abraham Johnson's house 140 poles. Thence West 106 poles Thence
North 68° W. 74 poles to intersect the old Road at the East end of Hehemesh Bates
Lane, at the small barn

At a Meeting of the Commissioners the following Report was
Made viz. Oct 6th 1817 was by order of the Commissioners of Madison County
have Met and viewed the alteration in the new Road prayed for by Mr. William
Saffin, as neither of the ways are yet open for Travelers we conclude the
way Mr. Saffin wants the Road to go is the soundest ground, and will
be the easiest kept in order for Travelers but it may be 5 or 6 poles the
