

Decemb 1<sup>st</sup> 1828

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County the  
reviewer appointed on the aforesaid road, made report in favor of said road  
being opened Whereupon it was ordered by the Commissioners that the report of the  
reviewer be recorded, (Licut) Beginning where the line between the Counties of Fayette  
and Madison cross the North fork of Paint Creek running from thence N 65 W  
100 poles, thence N 76 W 88 poles, passing through John Sattermouss lane, thence N 53 W  
288 poles passing the S.E. corner of John Fishers land Thence N 43 W 538 poles to the  
Old Federal Road, at the mouth of Thos Baldwins lane, and crossing the said North  
fork between Jacob Howsmans and the farm where Mr Parker lives distance  
three miles and 54 poles H Warner Surveyor

and it is further ordered by the Commissioners that said road be established  
and opened according to law Attest P. M. Linn C. B. C. M. C.

June 2<sup>d</sup> 1828

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition  
was presented praying for an alteration of the road from Lendant to Chillieth  
Beginning where the Columbus and Washington Road crosses said road, on the south  
side of the big hollow, thence S. at to strike the Rackliff line of Survey at or west of  
the house of Lewis Search and with or near the same to the county line to meet  
the contemplated alteration of said road in Fayette County

Ordered that Thos Anderson, John Smith and Abner Riccalle Reviewer  
and H Warner, Surveyor meet the 14<sup>th</sup> instant at the house of J. J. Smith running  
S 6 W 200 poles to Rackliffs corner thence South 320 poles with said Rackliff line  
to the county line And the Reviewer Thos Anderson, John J. Smith and  
Abner Riccalle reported in favor of said alteration = Whereupon it is ordered  
by the Commissioners that said alteration be established as a public highway  
and be opened according to law and the old part thereof be vacated

Ordered that Michael Rosbury Wm Guy, and Richard Baldwin Reviewers  
and J. S. Rathburn Surveyor meet at G. Danes the 18<sup>th</sup> inst and proceed to  
view Survey and make return thereof to the next Meeting of this board =
