

June 1st 1835

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a view and survey of a Road commencing at the finger board near Worthington's farm, on Sugar Run running thence with the Old Federal Road, to John Riccels thence on the line between said Riccels & P. Alkire to or near John M. Alkire's barn, thence on the line between said Alkire & S. Riccels to the corner between John M. Alkire & Wm. D. Wood, thence on the line between said Wood & Alkire passing through said Wood's Mill yard, and down the creek on the bank thereof to the lower corner of said Wood's fence, thence crossing the creek to the line between Mr. Arthur & John Riccels thence with said line passing through the lane between D. Wickles & P. Heath on the shortest and best route to the mouth of the lane between David Mantle & Edward Fitzgerald so as to intersect the Georgetown Road that comes in at or near that place

Whereupon John Fisher, Thomas Reever, & John Baldwin Viewers and Henry Warner Surveyor were appointed to meet at Worthington's farm, on the 16th this inst. & proceed to view & survey said Road & make report thereof to the next Meeting of this board according to law =

1835 Dec 7th Report returned favorable and Road;

56 1836 March 8th No Objections being presented the following Return is ordered to be recorded and opened according to Law to wit: Beginning at the finger board near Worthington's farm, at a point in the Old Federal Road, where the Old Yankeetown Road intersects said Federal Road, running thence N 65 E. 296 poles thence with said as originally run N 89 E. 24 poles to 1st Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to 2^d Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to 3^d Mile tree; Same course 134 poles crossing the Chellicothe Road, at 100 poles to the line between the lands of John Riccels & the heirs of Robt Alkire, thence with the same N 68 E. 168 poles to the S.E. corner of the said Riccels land, thence with the line of said Riccels and John Alkire's land N 28 W. 18 poles to 4th Mile tree; Same course 48 poles thence North 6 poles to the line between the lands of said heirs & others N 20 W. 130 poles, thence N 70 E. 104 poles to a point in W. D. Wood's Mill yard, thence down the creek N 74 E. 12 poles, thence N 23 E. 12 poles to the corner of said Wood's fence, thence N 67 E. 8 poles to 5th Mile tree; Same course 50 poles crossing the main branch of Deer Creek, thence N 80 E. 27 poles crossing a byre to the line between the lands of John Riccels and Duncan McArthur thence with said line N 15 W. 238 poles to the lane between Heath & Wickles, thence N 30 E. 5 poles to 6th Mile tree Same course 114 poles, thence N 1 E. 206 poles to 7th Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to 8th Mile tree; Same course 320 poles to 9th Mile tree; Same course 94 poles to the mouth of the lane between the lands of David Mantle and Edward Fitzgerald. Total distance 9 Miles and 94 poles
