

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison Co.  
 At a Meeting of the Commissioners on the 19<sup>th</sup> of August 1819  
 A petition was presented praying for a road from near the house of  
 David Clements where Daniel Powers now lived in Darby Township thence  
 in a southwardly direction until the said road strikes North eastwardly  
 corner of David Chaffmans Improvement thence running through the lane  
 near the house of Naham Kings and to intersect the County Road running  
 up and down Darby Creek at or near the house of Jeremy Philips in  
 Philips Township = Viewers were appointed to report to the next board  
 of Commissioners =

At the same Meeting a petition was presented praying for an alteration of  
 the east end of the road leading from Samuel Ewings to Joseph Matthews Mill  
 on big Darby so as to intersect the Post road at or near the house of Amasa Payne  
 to begin at the 2<sup>d</sup> bridge west of the North west line of North Liberty = Viewers  
 granted to make report to the next board of Commissioners =

15<sup>th</sup> Nov 1819 A petition was presented praying for a road beginning at  
 the County line of Fayette on the north fork of Paint to intersect a new road  
 laid out from Yankee Town to the County line of Fayette & Madison County  
 and pass John Baldwin thence up said Creek so to intersect the  
 Old Federal Road near Thomas Baldwin = Viewers granted Viewers Johnathan  
 M. Coffey, William Herold, William Wood, to meet at Samuel Coblesons  
 on the 30<sup>th</sup> Instant, P. M. Sene Surveyor; Order Issued

A Remonstrance was presented against a road commencing at or near  
 Chimmans Farm thence running making David Chaffman Naham King  
 and Jeremiah Philips preoccupied points and ending near Truman Bigelow  
 in Philips Township pray for a review granted; Reviewers Abraham Jacob  
 Samuel Sexton, Reuben Francis, Nehemiah Galt, Samuel Moore Order Issued on  
 consideration to consider that this road is superfluous

1820 May 10<sup>th</sup>  
 A petition of sundry inhabitants of Jefferson Township praying  
 for Reviewers to be appointed to view and make report to this board whether  
 an alteration on the road leading to Mechanicsburg from the Columbus  
 road to Springfield is necessary or not; The same is granted on proviso  
 that no east acres on the County in consequence thereof. Ordered that Samuel  
 Culbertson, John M. Donahoe, and William M. Gay Viewers do meet at the house  
 of Samuel Burnham on the last Saturday of this month with Samuel Daniel who all  
 being duly sworn proceed to view and survey and make report to this board at  
 their next Meeting

July 3<sup>d</sup> Report of Viewers in Obedience to the above Order (to wit)  
 We the Subscribers being required to meet at the house of Samuel Burnham  
 to view a part of the Mechanicsburg Road, agreeable to an order of the Honorable  
 board of Commissioners of the County of Madison after being duly qualified  
 proceeded to view the same, do make the following report (to wit)  
 That to begin at a stake in said Road about one mile from the Junction  
 with the Springfield Road and run first North fifty eight degrees West
