D Chapman reported he had surveyed said alteration as follows Beginning where said road leaves said wood land thence S 25 N 36 E pole to intersect said road at the south line of D Mitchells land, and the Review A Barr and S. M. Allen Report favorable. Whereupon the Board Order that said alteration be established as a public highway and the old part thereof be vacated =

To the Board of Commissioners of Madison County

Agreeably to your Order. We directed I proceeded on the 16<sup>th</sup> instant to survey the alteration of the Post Road Beginning near Simon Hages North East corner thence S 87 1/2 West 160 poles intersecting the Post Road at Abner Chafmans David Chapman

March 3<sup>d</sup> 1828

At a Meeting of the Board of Madison County a petition was presented by David Mitchell praying for Review to be appointed to view and report an alteration of the Road from Scribner Woods leading to Mechanicburgh on his own land to begin at a point in said Road, where it leaves said Woods land, thence S 25 N across said Mitchell land to the S. M. line thereof where it will intersect said Road again

Ordered that Masel Huntington Saml Allen, Absolam Kerr, Review and David Chapman Surveyor proceed to Meet at Saml Allens on the first Monday in April next and view and make Report of said alteration to the next Session of this board petitioners to pay all costs

March 3<sup>d</sup> 1828

At a Meeting of the Commissioners of Madison County a petition was presented praying for a Road as follows. Beginning between John Lattimours on the North fork of Paint Creek, so as to intersect the line between Madison County & Fayette near said Lattimours farm, thence the nearest and best way to the Old Federal Road between Thos Baldwin and Jacob Howsmans passing John Fishers South west corner thence westwardly near the line of the lands of said Fishers farm, thence so as to cross the North fork near the corner of the fence on the farm where Mrs Parker now lives or between said fence and Isaac Howsmans farm, thence to the said Federal Road,

Ordered that Richard Ayers Jonathan McCafferty & John Graham Review and Henry Warner Surveyor to Meet at Lattimours on the 14<sup>th</sup> inst and proceed to view survey & make Report to the next Meeting of this board,

Road Review returned Report favorable and Road, when a Remonstrance was presented against the same, on petition of G. Wallous & others whereupon Jonathan Minshall, George Chappell, David Walton, Amos S. Thompson, & George Phifer were appointed to Meet at John Lattimours on the 30 of this instant and proceed to review said Road and make Report to the next Meeting of this board according to law
