Deer Creek Township

Beginning at a stone N.W. corner to survey No. 12141 & 16096 Southerly corner to No. 9718 And corner to Henry Adair - Preston Adair & Carlton C. Gregg also a corner to Jefferson-Union & Fairfield Townships Thence with the line of Union Township $S 72 \frac{3}{4} W$ 284 poles to a pack oak in a road corner to David Dunkin & P. Adair Thence with the road and line of said Dunkin & Adair $S 63 \frac{1}{2} W$ 149 poles to a stone corner to Dunkin & Adair in the line of No. 553 Thence $S 86 W$ 640 poles crossing Deer Creek at 404 - Lafayette road at 548 poles to a stone in Joseph Neuman heirs land Thence $N 66^{\circ} 42' W$ 1116 poles crossing Turnpike at 285 - London & Lafayette road at 602 poles & the "Gwynne road" at 1031 poles to a large stone - 2 Black oaks & 2 Bur oaks corner to Somerford Township on A. Louland's land Thence with the line of said Township $N 11^{\circ} E$ 2255 poles crossing National Road at 462 poles (at a point $13 \frac{1}{2}$ poles east of the 24th mile post from Columbus) the Gwynne road at 830 poles - Deer Creek at 914 poles - "Urbana Pike" at 2100 poles to a stone in the line of Monroe Township on R. S. Dun's land. Thence with the line of Monroe Township $S 45^{\circ} 42' E$ 891 poles to a stone at the crossing of the "Urbana Pike" & "London Road" Thence with the southerly side of the Urbana Pike $S 55 \frac{1}{4} E$ 76, $S 65 \frac{1}{2} E$ 244, $S 59 E$ 248 - to cross roads -

$S67\frac{1}{2}E$ 226, $S73\frac{3}{4}E$ 60, $S53\frac{1}{2}E$ 85 poles to the
 line of Jefferson Township thence with said
 lines $S6E$ 589 poles crossing road at 292
 poles to a large stone at the point where the
 old state road crosses Glade run thence
 $S87\frac{1}{2}E$ 425 poles crossing road at 223 poles
 to a stone thence $S18E$ 480 poles crossing
 National Road 73 poles to a stone on the North
 side of W.J.-S.C.- & X. Turnpike thence $S4E$
 509 poles to the beginning
