# Range Township

Beginning at a Stone S. N. corner to Baskervills survey No. 6023; thence S. 24 N 50 poles to a stake in a pine; thence S. 21 N 5 miles and 200 3/4 poles to three jack oak saplings in the County line between Madison & Fayette Counties (crossing Bradford's fork at 36 poles Madison & Fayette turnpike at 96 1/3 poles, and the Federal road at 3 miles and 237 poles); thence with the county line S 89 E 9 miles and 187 1/2 poles to a stake, S. N. corner to Pleasant Township, standing 20 poles west of a branch of North Fork of Paint creek, said stake bears S 50 E 8 1/2 poles from a bur oak, and S 31 N 21 1/2 poles from another Bur oak (crossing East Fork of Paint creek at 2 miles and 210 poles, Bloomingburgh and Midway road at 3 miles 311 1/2 poles, Bloomingburgh and Cornville road at 5 miles 259 3/4 poles, North fork of Paint creek at 8 miles and 186 3/4 poles, following down it some distance before and after crossing, and the road leading from Midway to Yankee town at 8 miles and 219 poles); thence with the Pleasant Township line S 1 E 5 miles and 300 poles to a stake in the southerly line of Oakum Township (crossing Mud run at 1 mile and 276 poles, Federal road at 3 miles and 38 1/2 poles, branch of Bradford's Fork at 3 miles and 25 poles, Main Bradford at 4 miles and 83 poles, again at 4 miles and 132 poles, and again at 4 miles and 186 poles); thence with said line S 54 N 1 mile and 289 poles to a stake in the line between Isaac McClimens and Eli N. Gwynne; thence with said

line N 50 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 134 poles to a stone corner to E. W. Gwynne; thence N 80 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 224 poles to a double black oak corner to John Foster and David McClimans (crossing Bradford's Fork at 74 poles, a branch at 158 poles; thence N 29 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 273 poles to a branch of Bradford's Fork; (passing corner between James McClimans and Thomas G. Foster at 247 poles); thence with the meanders of said branch of Bradford's Fork S 45 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 8; S 59 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 16; S 38 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 29; N 83 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 13; S 27 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; S 43 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; N 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 14; S 86 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 26, to James McClimans corner; thence N 40 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 19; N 89 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 29; N 67 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 12; S 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 3; S 81 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 20; S 26 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 37; N 86 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; N 47 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 53; N 8 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 18; N 45 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 38; N 62 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 18; S 77 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; N 58 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 40; N 77 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 17; N 42 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 10; N 79 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 16; S 61 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 14; N 38 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 16; to the line between Mrs. Johnson Sr and Mrs. Johnson Jr; thence with their line S 48 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 34 to a stake in the Gent's town road; thence with said road N 41 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 158 $\frac{1}{2}$  poles to a stake; thence N 35 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 45 poles to a stake; thence S 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  W 2 miles and 233 poles, (passing near Robert Beads house) to beginning.
