


Surveyed for Thomas Bell, 1333-1/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 305, on the northwest of the Ohio, and on Deer-Creek, a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at a hickory, ash and elm, easterly corner to Churchill Jones Survey No. 1315, running with his line S. 69 W. 320 poles, crossing Deer Creek at 200 poles to a white oak, southerly corner to Jones; thence S. 45 E 534 poles, crossing a branch at 354 poles to four white oaks; thence N. 69 E. 500 poles, crossing the creek at 303 poles to a stake; thence N. 56 W. 600 poles to a stake; thence S. 69 W. 52 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for Joel Gressel 200 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 2018 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at a sugar tree, red oak, elm and hickory in the line of Andrew Duncomb's Survey No. 3674 and northeast corner to Thomas Sheldon's Survey No. 1238; thence with Sheldon's line, West 200 poles, crossing a branch at 54 poles to two hickories in Sheldon's line; thence North 160 poles to a stake in a prairie; thence East 200 poles crossing the branch at 135 poles to a black oak, red oak and two hickories; thence South 160 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Miles Jennings heirs, 200 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 2152, on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at three elms and a forked black walnut, northeast corner to Charles Ballow's Survey No. 540, running with his line West 200 poles to a stake in a large prairie, northwest corner to Ballow; thence North 160 poles to a stake in a large prairie; thence East 200 poles crossing a branch at 186 poles to three post white oaks at the edge of a prairie; thence South 160 poles crossing the branch at 100 poles to the beginning.
