


Surveyed for Robert Means, assee, 260 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5240 on Gladly run, a branch of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Black Oak and three White Oaks, Northerly corner to Duncan McArthur's Survey No. 5195; thence with his upper line S. 62 W. 180 poles, crossing Gladly run at 122 poles to a Hickory and White Oak; thence N. 11 W. 160 poles to a Black Oak and White Oak; thence S. 75 E. 112 poles, crossing the run to a White Oak; thence N. 15 E. 76 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 75 W. 34 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 10 W. 80 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 80 E. 86 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 10 E. 138 poles passing the Northwest corner of Walter Dun's Survey No. 9231 and with his line to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 70 E. 70 poles crossing a small branch to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 10 E. 102 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory; thence East 30 poles to a Black Oak; thence S. 30 E. 97 poles to four Elms; thence S. 60 W. 56 poles to a White Oak and forked Black Oak in the line of McArthur's said Survey thence with said line North 16 poles to three Black Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence with his line N. 40 W. 174 poles crossing a small branch to the beginning.



Surveyed for George Hoffman, assee, 500 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5521 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a White Oak, Southwest corner to a private Survey of 50 acres made for Charles Atchison, running S. 67 E. 64 poles to an Elm; thence N. 23 E. 136 poles to a Burr Oak in the line of Mathew Arbuckle dec'd. Survey No. 3900; thence with said line S. 67 E. 60 poles to a forked Hickory; thence S. 20 E. 395 poles to a Stake; thence West 305 poles to a Stake; thence North 295 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for George Hoffman, assee, 130 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5521, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a Black Oak in the Southerly line of the Representatives of Mathew Arbuckle's Survey No. 3900 and Northerly corner to Robert Mean's Entry No. 5971; thence with said line N. 67 W. 130 poles to a White Oak in said line; thence S. 23 W. 160 poles to four White Oaks; thence S. 67 E. 130 poles to three Hickories in the line of said Mean's Said Entry; thence with said line, N. 23 E. 160 poles to the beginning.
