


Surveyed for Richard C. Anderson, 600 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5552, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at three White Oaks and two Dogwood's, Southerly corner to William Heth's Survey No. 4752, running S. 60 W. 436 poles, crossing a branch at 60 at 80 and at 126 poles to three White Oaks in the line of William Bond's Survey No. 5294; thence with

his line S. 56 E. 103 poles to two Black Oaks and a Bur Oak, Easterly corner to said Bond's Survey; thence S. 34 W. 40 poles to a Bur Oak, Black Oak and Hickory, in said Bond's line and Northerly corner to James Low's Survey No. 5193; thence with Low's line S. 56 E. 130 poles to three Bur Oaks and a Black Oak, in the line of said Low's Survey; thence N. 34 E. 40 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence East 108 poles to a forked Bur Oak and Hickory; thence N. 60 E. 158 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 38 W. 92 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory; thence N. 52 E. 174 poles, crossing a branch at 40 poles to a Bur Oak and Black Oak; thence S. 37 W. 160 poles to three White Oaks from one root, in the line of said Heth's Survey; thence with his line S. 53 W. 52 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for Richard C. Anderson, 133-1/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5552, on the waters of Treacles Creek. Beginning at a Black Oak and Hickory in the line of Jesse Gladden and Isme Bailey's Survey No. 6299, 70 poles N. 79 E. from their Southwest corner, running S. 11 E. 133-1/3 poles to two Red Oaks and a Hickory;

thence N. 79 E. 160 poles to two Bur Oaks and two Elms; thence N. 11 W. 133-1/3 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in the line of said Gladden and Bailey's Survey; thence with their line S. 79 W. 160 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Richard Apperson, 300 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5134, on the waters of Treacles Creek. Beginning at a White Oak and Bur Oak, East corner to Stanton and Bailey's Survey No. 4735, running with their line N. 45 W. 38 poles to two White Oaks in said line, South corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5301; thence with Mean's line N. 45 E. 50 poles

to two White Oaks in said line; thence S. 45 E. 100 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 56 E. 82 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 45 E. 114 poles to three White Oaks; thence S. 55 W. 368 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence N. 45 W. 112 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 45 E. 230 poles, passing Bailey and Stanton's South corner and with their line to the beginning.
