

line S. 67 E. 188 poles to two Hickories and an Elm in said line; thence N. 15 E. 154 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 67 W. 62 poles to two Elms and an Ash; thence N. 23 E. 22 poles to an Elm in a prairie; thence N. 52 W. 108 poles to two Black Oaks and an Elm; thence S. 60 W. 178 poles to three White Oaks from one root; thence N. 26 W. 92 poles to a forked White Oak; thence N. 76 W. 62 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence S. 14 W. 130 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence S. 37 E. 10 poles to a Stake; thence S. 67 E. 200 poles to two White Oaks in the line of said Shull's Survey; thence with his line N. 23 E. 20 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 180 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5378 on the Spring fork of Treacles creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Northwesterly corner to Thomas M. Bayley's Survey No. 6006, running N. 15 E. 200 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 75 E. 160 poles crossing the Spring fork at 40 poles to a Red Oak, Bur Oak and Hickory; thence S. 15 W. 220 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, corner to said Bayley's Survey; thence with his line

N. 67 W. 160 poles crossing the fork at 108 poles to the beginning.



Beginning at three White Oaks in the line of Sigismond Stribling's Entry, S.E. corner of Elias Rector's Survey No. 5648, running S. 20 W. 136 poles to a Black Oak and two White Oaks; thence N. 70 W. 60 poles to a Black Oak; thence N. 20 E. 136 poles to a Stake in the line of said Rector's Survey; thence S. 70 E. 60 poles with his line to the beginning.

Beginning at two Black Oaks and a Hickory, S.W. corner to Elias Rector's Survey No. 5648, running with his line, passing his corner N. 20 E. 210 poles to two Elms; thence N. 70 W. 140 poles to a Bur Oak and two Hickories; thence S. 19 E. 36 poles to a Bur Oak; thence West 56 poles to a forked Black Oak; thence South 60 poles to a White Oak; thence S. 35 E. 185 poles to the beginning.
