





Surveyed for Charles Woodson, assee. 407 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 5485, on Lebbegut a branch of Oppossum run, a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at eight Hickories, Easterly corner to Henry Flesher's Survey No. 5190; thence S. 38 E. 218 poles to a Black Oak and White Oak; thence S. 52 W. 300 poles crossing Lubbergut at 80 poles and a branch at 106 poles to a Hickory and White Oak; thence N. 38 W. 218 poles crossing a branch at 195 poles to a Black Oak, Hickory and Small Ash; thence to the Southerly corner of Flesher's said Survey and with the line thereof N. 52 E. 300 poles crossing Lubbergut and a branch to the beginning.
