


Surveyed for George Galloway, assee. 180 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5717 on the waters of Paint creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a Black Oak Southwest corner to Archibald Finley's Survey No. 4890, running S. 74 W. 82 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 54 W. 50 poles to an Elm and Bur Oak; thence N. 36 E. 14 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 43 W. 36 poles to an Elm; thence S. 58 W. 62 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence S. 14 W. 54 poles to an Elm; thence S. 85 W. 88 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence South 40 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 65 E. 120 poles to three Black Oaks; thence East 120 poles to three Hickories; thence N. 20 E. 88 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 67 E. 14 poles to a White Oaks; thence N. 65 E. 64 poles to an Ash and two Elms; thence North 34 poles to a Bur Oak in the line of said Finley's Survey; thence with his line West 40 poles to the beginning.


James Galloway, Jur. D.S.

Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 50 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5864 on the lower side of Darby's creek. Beginning at an Elm upper corner on the creek to Lucas Sullivant's Survey No. 3313, running with his line N. 78 W. 112 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 5 W. 86 poles crossing a branch at 24 poles to three small Black Oaks; thence East 84 poles to a Stake; thence S. 12 E. 52 poles crossing a branch to a Bur Oak, Blue Ash and Hackberry, on the bank of the Creek; thence down the creek with the meanders thereof S. 60 E. 20, S. 25 E. 28, S. 19 W. 24 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 60 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5717, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, 62 poles N. 67 W. from John Marcus's cabin, about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles westerly from James Ewing's on Darby's creek, running S. 19 E. 79 poles, crossing a branch to three White Oaks; thence N. 55 E. 132 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 52 W. 108 poles, crossing the branch to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 35 W. 83 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 120 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5875 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak and two Black Oaks in the back line of said Galloway's Survey No. 5125, ninety poles from the upper back corner of said Survey, running S. 15 W. 42 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 82 W. 152 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 2 W. 174 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 83 E. 142 poles to a Stake; thence S. 10 E. 140 poles, passing the upper back corner of said Galloway's Survey, and with his line to the beginning.
