


Surveyed for James Galloway, Jun. assee. 55 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5875 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at three hickories and a White Oak, Southeast corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5097, and corner to John Moore's Survey No. 6508, running with Moore's line, North 50 poles to three small Black Oaks; thence East 60 poles to three Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence South 48 poles to two Bur Oaks and an Elm; thence East 40 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Cherry tree; thence South 30 poles crossing a branch at 8 poles, to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 20 W. 60 poles to a Stake; thence west 46 poles to a stake in the line of said Moore's Survey; thence with his line N. 20 W. 91 poles, crossing a branch to the beginning.



Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. Assee. 140 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5717, on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two White Thorns and an Elm, Southeast corner to the Representatives of James Winkfield's Survey No. 4573, running with his line North 116 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory, Northeast corner to his survey; thence East 234 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence S. 31 W. 136 poles to three Bur Oaks and an Elm; thence West 164 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 133-1/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5717 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at three Black Oaks, Northwest corner to Galloway and Bayly's Survey No. 5719 & 5720, running north 20 poles to a Bur Oak; thence East 176 poles to a Bur Oak, Red Oak and Hickory; thence North 20 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 32 poles to a forked Hickory; thence N. 23 E. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 80 E. 28 poles to three Hickories, Southeast corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5982; thence with his line East 148 poles crossing a branch at 32 poles to two Black Oaks, Southeast corner to said Mean's and in the line of Robert Jones' Survey No. 1341; thence with Jones' line South 95 poles to an Elm, Southwest corner to said Jones' Survey and Northeast corner to said Galloway and Bayly's Survey; thence with their line N. 86 1/2 W. 400 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Thomas Worthington, assee. 60 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5846 on the waters of Bradford's fork of Deercreek. Beginning at five white oaks, Southwesterly corner to said Worthington's Entry No. 5456; thence North 26 poles, crossing a branch to a Stake in the line of the said Entry; thence West 80 poles to three White Oaks in the line of said Worthington's Survey No. 5454; thence with the said line South 114 poles, crossing a branch to a Hickory and Black Oaks, Southeasterly corner to the said survey; thence East 91 poles to five White Oaks and a Hickory; thence North 88 poles to a Stake in the line of said Entry No. 5456; thence with said line West 11 poles to the beginning.
