


Surveyed for Daniel Bedinger 492½ acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5806, on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a White Oak and Hickory, an Easterly corner of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4516; thence North 163 poles to two Elms, Northeast corner to said Survey; thence West 257 poles to a Hickory, Elm and Black Walnut in the line of Robert Mean's Survey No. 4424; thence N. 20 E. 250 poles to two Hickories, Southeasterly corner to said Survey and Southwesterly corner to William Reynold's Survey No. 4423; thence N. 47deg. 8' E. 164 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, Southeasterly corner to Reynolds; thence S. 37 E. 194 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence S. 10° 30' W. 381 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5661, on the waters of Treacles' Creek. Beginning at two White Oaks in the line of Frederick Stanton and Daniel Bailey's Survey No. 4735, and East corner to James Towler's Survey No. 4804, running with Towler's line, S. 45 W. 130 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 45 E. 70 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Black Oak; thence S. 37 W. 86 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 35 E. 78 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 55 E. 50 poles to two Hickories; thence N. 35 W. 48 poles to a Black Oak; thence N. 55 E. 137 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of Richard Apperson's Survey No. 6312; thence with his line N. 45 W. 94 poles to a Stake, West corner to said Apperson's Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 45 E. 36 poles to a Stake, South corner to said Stanton and Bailey's Survey; thence with their line N. 45 W. 52 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for the Representatives of Richard Call, decd. 74 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5232, on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at three White Oaks, Southwest corner to James Galloway Jur's Survey No. 6204, running with his line East 198 poles to a Black Oak and White Oak, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence South 60 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 198 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence North 60 poles to the beginning.
