


Surveyed for Elias Langham and John and Mathew Hobson, assees. 165 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Langham 115 acres on No. 4944 and Hobsons 50 acres on No. 5878 on the waters of Walnut Run a branch of Oak run. Beginning at a Stake in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4387, and corner to the Representatives of William Sanford's Entry No. 6053; thence with Helphenstine's line East 165 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to Entry No. 6064; thence with the line of said Entry, South 160 poles to a Black Oak and White Oak; thence West 165 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root, Southeast corner to the Representatives of Sanford's said Entry; thence with their line North 160 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for Daniel Brown, assee, 150 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants 50 acres on No. 5474 and 100 acres on No. 5475 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak in the line of John Campbell's Survey No. 5104, 60 poles East of his Northwest corner; thence East 160 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory in said line; thence North 150 poles to a large White Oak; thence West 160 poles to three White Oaks; thence South 150 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for John Graham, assee. 82 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5786 on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning N. 53 E. 397 poles from the Southerly corner of James Johnstons Survey No. 7239, at two Bur oaks; thence N. 19 E. 74 poles crossing a branch at 50 poles to a Bur Oak; thence East 150 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 19 W. 88 poles crossing the branch at 40 poles to six Bur Oaks and a Jack Oak; thence S. 77 W. 84 poles to a stake in a prairie; thence N. 63 W. 70 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Graham, assee. 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5786, on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and a Hickory, Westerly corner to John Morris Survey No. 6508; thence S. 79 W. 136 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence N. 11 W. 55 poles crossing a branch at 6 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 49 E. 124 poles to a Bur Oak; thence East 90 poles to a Stake near two White Oaks; cornered in the line of Moore's Survey; thence with said line S. 20 W. 117 poles crossing the branch to the beginning.
