


Surveyed for John Graham assee. 70 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants 58 acres on No. 5786 and 12 acres on No. 5787 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning S. 43 W. 46 poles from the Southwesterly corner of Walter Dun's Entry No. 7242 at five Bur Oaks; thence S. 63 E. 60 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 27 W. 120 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 63 W. 75 poles to two bur oaks from one root; thence N. 22 W. 60 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of the prairie; thence N. 63° 50' E. 102 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for John Graham, assee. 91 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5787 on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 7063; thence N. 88 W. 16 poles to three Bur Oaks on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 10 E. 118 poles to a Bur Oak, White Oak and Jack Oak; thence East 54 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 68 E. 60 poles to six bur Oaks, four of them from one root and two from another; thence South 28 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence S. 18 W. 130 poles to a White Oak and two Hickories in Galloway's line; thence with said line N. 52 W. 94 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for John Graham, assee. 42 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5786 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at three Dogwoods from one root, corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 5097; thence with his line North 10 poles to a Bur Oak and Small Red Elm; thence N. 85 E. 120 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence South 50 poles crossing a branch at 16 poles to a Stake near two Bur Oaks, cornered; thence S. 80 W. 121 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in Mean's line; thence with his line North 51 poles, crossing the branch to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Graham, assee. 45 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5787 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning S. 34 E. 95 poles from the lower corner on the creek of Lucas Sullivant's Survey No. 3162, at two Hickories; thence East 94 poles to two Bur Oaks on the East Side of a road; thence South 78 poles, crossing a branch at 64 poles to a Small Jack Oak and two forked Bur Oaks on the edge of the plains; thence West 94 poles to Stake in a prairie; thence North 78 poles crossing the branch at 38 poles to the beginning.
