



Beginning at two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Southeasterly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 6320, running with the line of said Survey N. 15 E. 200 poles to a Red Oak, Bur Oak and Hickory, Northeast corner to said Survey; thence S. 75 E. 160 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 22 E. 64 poles to a White Oak, Hickory and Bur Oak; thence S. 75 E. 140 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence S. 15 E. 172 poles to two Bur Oaks and an Elm; thence N. 75 W. 84 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence S. 15 E. 24 poles to three Bur Oaks, two from one root; thence N. 75 W. 96 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 58 W. 162 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for James Galloway, Jur. assee. 350 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 140 acres on No. 5976 and 200 acres on No. 5974 on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacles creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Easterly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 6649, running with said line N. 48 W. 100 poles to a Stake corner to said Survey in the line of Thomas M. Bayley's Survey No. 6022; thence with Bayly's line East 34 poles to a Hickory, Bur Oak and Black Oak, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 6 E. 200 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 188 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence South 160 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 25 W. 232 poles to a Stake, Northeasterly corner to the Representatives of Nicholas Hobson's Survey No. 6350; thence with their line N. 80 W. 120 poles to a Stake in the line of said Galloway's former Survey; thence with his line N. 30 E. 96 poles to the beginning.

Beginning N. 19 E. 12 poles from the beginning corner of John Graham's Survey No. 7385 of 82 acres, at a Stake near a Bur Oak and Small Black Oak cornered; thence N. 19 E. 62 poles crossing a branch at 38 poles to a Bur Oak, Northwesterly corner to said Graham's Survey; thence N. 74 W. 185 poles to four Elms and a Bur Oak; thence S. 6 E. 162 poles crossing the branch at 44 poles to a Hickory, Bur Oak and Jack Oak; thence N. 70 E. 150 poles to the beginning.
