


Surveyed for Gross Scruggs, assee. 200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5916, on the waters of Glady run of Deer creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks and a White Oak on the edge of a prairie, S. 82 E. 224 poles from the most Southerly corner of Robert Mean's Entry No. 5652; thence N. 80 E. 67 poles to three Bur Oaks in the edge of a prairie; thence S. 83 E. 77 poles to two Hickories; thence S. 22 E. 226 poles to four Bur Oaks on the edge of a prairie; thence S. 45 W. 96 poles to four Hickories; thence West 42 poles to a Hickory and two large Black Oaks; thence N. 22 W. 172 poles to a Jack Oak and Hickory; thence N. 27 W. 128 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for James Johnston 88 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5792 on the waters of Deercreek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root, Northerly corner to Ebenezer Owen's Survey No. 3902 and Easterly corner to the Representatives of Matthew Arbuckle's Survey No. 3901; thence S. 78 E. 102 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak; thence N. 35 E. 129 poles to a Stake; thence N. 30 W. 43 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence N. 55 W. 44 poles to three Hickories; thence S. 38 W. 187 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for John Ewing, assee. 100 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 348 on the waters of Treacles creek. Beginning at two White Oaks, Southeasterly corner to No. 7676. 100 acres. Duncan McArthur's Survey No. 4769; thence with his line

N. 55 E. 300 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, Easterly corner to said Survey in the line of Thomas Holt's Survey No. 5291; thence S. 35 E. $53\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of Walter Dun's Survey No. 8414; thence S. 55 W. 300 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory in the line of Lewis Springer's Survey No. 7946; thence with said line N. 35 W. $53\frac{1}{2}$ poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Joseph Ladd, assee. 200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6008 on Bradford's fork of Deer creek. Beginning at two White Oaks, South corner to Elias Langham's Survey No. 4777, South corner to Jesse McKay's Survey No. 5890 and 7623 and West corner to Thomas No. 6498; Worthington's Survey; thence N. 45 E. $123\frac{1}{3}$ poles to a Stake corner to said Worthington's Survey; thence with and binding on a line of said Survey and Benjamin W. Ladd's Survey No. 6432, N. 45 W. 260 poles, crossing the fork three times to a Hickory and White Oak, Easterly corner to said McKay's Survey; thence S. 45 W. $123\frac{1}{3}$ poles crossing the fork to a White Oak and Black Oak, corner to said Survey; thence S. 45 E. 260 poles to the beginning.
