


Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 220 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6075 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root, N. 55 E. 164 poles from two Bur Oaks, Northwesterly corner to Rice Haggard's Survey No. 7056; thence N. 4 W. 58 poles to three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root; thence N. 10 E. 133 poles crossing a branch at 70 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 43 E. 60 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 85 E. 100 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 75 E. 51 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root, one of them forked; thence S. 14 W. 104 poles crossing the branch at 48 poles to five Bur Oaks from two roots; thence S. 34 W. 168 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 88° 30' W. 100 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for Walter Dnn, assee. 220 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6075, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, most Westerly corner of John



Graham's Survey No. 7385; thence South 180 poles crossing a branch at 172 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence S. 63 E. 76 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence N. 52° 30' E. 58 poles crossing a branch at 34 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence N. 25 E. 72 poles to two small Bur Oaks; thence N. 82 E. 80 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 6 E. 111 poles crossing a branch at 87 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northwesterly corner to Rice Haggard's Survey No. 7056; thence N. 44 W. 86 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, Easterly corner to said Graham's Survey; thence with his line S. 19 W. 88 poles crossing a branch at 40 poles to Six Bur Oaks and a Jack Oak, corner to said Graham; thence with another of his lines S. 77 W. 84 poles to a Stake in a prairie, another of Graham's corners; thence with another of his lines N. 63 W. 70 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Gross Scruggs, assee. and Walter Dun, assee. 100 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Scruggs 56 acres on No. 5016 and Dun 44 acres on No. 5493, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at a Hickory, Bur Oak and Jack Oak, Southerly corner to James Johnston's Survey No. 7416; thence S. 58 W. 80 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of said Johnston's Survey No. 7239; thence with said line South 60 poles to a Bur Oak in said line; thence S. 65 E. 100 poles to a forked Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence N. 46 E. 76 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root; thence North 121 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in the line of said Johnston's Survey No. 7416; thence with said line S. 70 W. 83 poles to the beginning.
