


Surveyed for Gross Scruggs, assee. 90 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5916 on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak Southerly corner to James Johnston's Survey No. 7241; thence N. 14 E. 141 poles crossing a branch at 61 poles to four Bur Oaks, Easterly corner to the said Survey; thence N. 30 W. 61 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 60 E. 130 poles to a Hickory and two White Oaks from one root in the line of John Graham's Survey No. 7388; thence with said line S. 10 W. 14 poles to three Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to Graham's said Survey; thence S. 88 E. 16 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to Graham and Northerly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 7063; thence with Galloway's line S. 35 W. 83 poles to two Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to Galloway's said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 19 E. 79 poles crossing a branch to three White Oaks, Southerly corner to Galloway; thence S. 21° 30' E. 12 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 55 W. 41 poles to two White Oaks; thence S. 51 W. 99 poles to the beginning.



Beginning at two Bur Oaks, one of them forked and a Hickory S. 19 E. 196 poles from the Easterly corner of said Scrugg's Survey No. 7628; thence S. 87 E. 81 poles to two Hickories, one of them forked and a Bur Oak; thence S. 20 E. 81 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak; thence S. 54 W. 152 poles to four Bur Oaks, two of them from one root; thence N. 18° 30' W. 184 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence S. 87 E. 71 poles to the beginning.



Beginning at two Bur Oaks, N. 86° 30' E. 80 poles from the Easterly corner of said Scrugg's Survey No. 7812; thence S. 10 E. 132 poles to two Bur Oaks and two Hickories; thence N. 75 E. 112 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 12 E. 120 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 84 W. 157 poles to the beginning.

Beginning at a Stake in a prairie in a line of said "orthington's Survey No. 7612; thence with said line East 134 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 3 E. 118 poles to two Hickories in said line; thence S. 87 W. 135 poles to two Bur Oaks, a White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 3 W. 123 poles to the beginning.
