



Surveyed for Nathan Haines, assee. 3200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6016 on the waters of Darby's and Treacle's creek. Beginning at an Ash and large forked Bur Oak, upper back corner to Samuel Wallace's Survey No. 2881, in the lower line of the said Wallace's Survey No. 2882; thence with the said line N. 53 E. 44 poles to three Bur Oaks, lower back corner to Survey No. 2882; thence with the back line of the said Survey and passing the upper back corner thereof at 340 poles, N. 21 W. 583 poles to a Stake in a large prairie; thence N. 76 E. 830 poles crossing a branch to four Bur Oaks on the edge of a prairie; thence S. 10 E. 634 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of James Galloway's Survey No. 5744; thence with said line West 252 poles passing the Northwesterly corner of Galloway's said Survey at 150 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northwesterly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 7285; thence with the line of said Survey, South 116 poles crossing Three mile run to two Black Oaks and a White Oak, Southwesterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 70° 30' W. 414 poles to a Bur Oak and large Hickory in the back line of said Wallace's Survey No. 2881; thence with said line N. 37 W. 160 poles to the beginning.
