



Surveyed for Gross Scruggs, assee. 550 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5916 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning N. 45° 30' W. 277 poles from the Northerly corner of James Mc^{utt}'s Survey No. 4751, at a Hickory and large Bur Oak; thence N. 82 W. 64 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence West 154 poles to two White Oaks and a Bur Oak; thence N. 22 W. 130 poles to three White Oaks; thence N. 51 E. 95 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence N. 52° 30' E. 168 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 84 E. 152 poles to five Hickories; thence S. 71 E. 80 poles to three Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence S. 15 E. 24 poles to five Bur Oaks, four of them from one root; thence S. 71 W. 60 poles to a Hickory, White Oak and Black Oak; thence N. 80° 30' W. 99 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence S. 23 W. 119 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for John Graham and Gross Scruggs, assees. 345 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Graham 84 acres on No. 5765 and Scruggs 261 acres on No. 5916, on Gladly run, a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak on the edte of the run prairie, S. 48 E. 278 poles from the lower back corner of James Galloway's Survey No. 5996; thence East 82 poles to a Bur Oak; thence South 36 poles to two Hickories; thence S. 35 E. 35 poles to a Black Oak, Hickory and Bur Oak; thence South 192 poles to a large Elm; thence S. 33 W. 88 poles to four Black Oaks and a Bur Oak; thence West 105 poles crossing the run at 92 poles to a forked Bur Oak on the edte of the run prairie; thence N. 11 W. 336 poles to a large Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence East 116 poles crossing two branches to the beginning.

Surveyed for Gross Scruggs, assee. 130 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5916 on the waters of Treacle's creek. Beginning at a Hickory and Bur Oak, N. 86 E. 120 poles from the 17 mile tree on the State road from Franklinton to Springfield; thence S. 20 W. 85 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 60 E. 161 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory; thence N. 11 E. 86 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 70 E. 24 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 2 E. 94 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 64 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 19 E. 9 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 82 W. 86 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 51 W. 6 poles to the beginning.
