


Surveyed for John Baldwin 225 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6019 on the waters of the North fork of Paint creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Southeast corner to William McKee's Survey No. 5900; thence with his line North 22 poles to four Bur Oaks in said line; thence N. 50 E. 33 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 72 E. 52 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 40 W. 63 poles to five Bur Oaks; thence South 230 poles to a Bur Oak; thence West 104 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence North 40 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 150 poles to a Bur Oak; thence North 133 poles to two Bur Oaks, corner to Ladds and Norvill's Survey No. 9096; and 9641; thence with their line N. 50 E. 122 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Easterly corner to their Survey in the line of McKee's said Survey; thence with his line, East 26 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Daniel Duval 660 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 2483 on the waters of Paint Creek. Beginning at a forked Jack Oak and Hickory, Southeast corner to John Peyton's Survey No. 1244; thence East 238 poles to three Bur Oaks, Southwest corner to William Robinson and William Creighton's Survey No. 6050, 7263 & 7799; thence with their line North 445 poles to a Stake in said line; thence West 238 poles to a Stake in the line of said Peyton's Survey; thence with his line South 445 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for William Robinson, assee. 250 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5945 on the waters of the East fork of Paint creek. Beginning at a stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to John Moore and William Creighton's Survey No. 5476 & 5672; thence East 235 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to said Moore and Creighton's Survey; thence South 130 poles to a Stake; thence East 80 poles crossing a branch to a Stake, Southeast corner to said Moore and Creighton's Survey; thence South 30 poles to a Stake in the line of said Robinson and William Creighton's No. 6050, 7263 & 7799 of 1517 acres; thence West 315 poles to a Stake in the line of Survey No. 6347; thence North 160 poles to the beginning.
