


Surveyed for James Innis, 666-2/3 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 2214 on the northwest of the Ohio and on Deer Creek, a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at two hickorys a mulberry and white oak, northwest corner to said Innis's former Survey No. 1727, running with his former line S. 20 W. 400 poles crossing Deer Creek at 200 poles and a branch at 330 poles, to a stake, S.W. corner to his former Survey; thence N. 70 W. 267 poles to two white oaks and two hickories; thence N. 20 E. 400 poles crossing the Creek at 380 poles to a stake; thence S. 70 E. 267 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Major General Steuben, 1150 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 104, on the northwest of the Ohio and on Deer Creek, a branch of the Scioto. Beginning at an ash, white oak and maple, northeast corner to James Innis Survey No. 1727, running with Innis line S. 20 W. 400 poles crossing Deer Creek at 108 to a stake, southeast corner to Innis; thence S. 21 E. 374 poles to three small ash on a trace; thence N. 69 E. 320 poles crossing the Creek at 160 poles to three elms; thence N. 18 W. 670 poles to a stake; thence S. 69 W. 84 poles to the beginning.
