

Surveyed for James Johnston and John Graham, assees. 800 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Johnston 300 acres on No. 5792 and Graham 500 acres on No. 5791, on the waters of Darby and Treacle's creek. Beginning at four Elms, lower back corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 5743 and corner to Joseph Swearingen's Survey No. 4820, 4945 & 5207; thence with Galloway's back line N. 28 W. 134 poles to a Stake in said line, Southerly corner to Tuttle Hudson's Survey No. 6223; thence with Hudson's line N. 8 W. 258 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory, corner to Hudson; thence with another of his lines N. 84 W. 47 poles to a Bur Oak and Elm, another of Hudson's corners; thence with another of his lines N. 6 E. 76 poles, passing Hudson's Northeasterly corner at 72 poles to two Elms and a Maple, corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 6602; thence with the line of said Survey, N. 70 E. 290 poles to two Black Oaks and a Bur Oak, Southerly corner to Galloway's said Survey; thence N. 75° 30' E. 86 poles to two Bur Oaks, northwesterly corner to said Graham's Survey No. 7393; thence with his line S. 33 E. 164 poles to two Black Oaks and a small Hickory, corner to Graham; thence with another of his lines S. 30 W. 84 poles to two large Bur Oaks corner to Graham; thence S. 52 W. 94 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to GRAHAM; thence S. 15 W. 32 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, most Westerly corner to said Graham's Survey No. 7392; thence with the line of the said Survey, correcting the course thereof, N. 71° 30' W. 176 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Anthony Walke, assee. 112 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6050, on Barren run, a branch of Treacle's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks and a Black Oak, Southeasterly corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7482; thence with his line N. 34 E. 134 poles crossing Barron run to three Black Oaks from one root and a Bur Oak, Easterly corner to said Survey; thence S. 39 E. 65 poles to three Hickories; thence S. 17 E. 52 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 14° 30' W. 105 poles crossing the run to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence N. 75 W. 118 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 12 W. 64 poles, crossing a branch at 20 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory on the edge of a prairie; thence S. 85 E. 22 poles to the beginning.
