

Surveyed for Walter Dun, Gross Scruggs and John Graham, assees. 480 acres of land on part of eight Military Warrants, Dun 102 acres on No. 6086, 70 acres on No. 6089, 10 acres on No. 6126, 53 acres on No. 5493, 7 acres on No. 5547, Scruggs 127 acres on No. 5916 and Graham 18 acres on No. 5791 and 93 acres on No. 5832, on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacle's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks and an Elm, Southeasterly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 7402; thence with his line N. 75 W. 18 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line; thence S. 16 W. 124 poles to a Stake; thence N. 71 E. 206 poles to a forked bur Oak; thence S. 49° 30' E. 83 poles to a Hickory, White Oak and Black Oak; thence S. 87 E. 100 poles, crossing a branch at 60 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root in the edge of a prairie; thence N. 34 E. 60 poles crossing a branch at 10 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 42 E. 132 poles to a Black Oak and White Oak thence N. 62 E. 40 poles to a three pronged White Oak in the line of Simon Nicholson's Survey No. 5578; thence with said line N. 67 W. 56 poles, crossing a branch at 33 poles to two Bur Oaks corner to Nicholson; thence N. 83 W. 102 poles to a Bur Oak and Black Oak Southwesterly corner to Nicholson's said Survey and in the line of William Raleigh's Survey No. 5483 & 5484; thence with said line S. 7 W. 23 poles to a Black Oak and two Hickories, Southeasterly corner to Releigh's; thence with another of his lines N. 83 W. 132 poles crossing Elk horn run at 130 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, corner to Raleigh's said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 7 E. 12 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Raleigh; thence with another of his lines N. 40 W. 202 poles crossing a branch at 90 poles and one at 200 poles to two Bur Oaks on the edge of a prairie in said line; thence S. 50 W. 104 poles crossing a branch at 8 poles to three Bur Oaks in the line of Galloway's said Survey; thence with said line S. 75 E. 83 poles crossing a branch to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, Northeasterly corner to Galloway's said Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 15 W. 175 poles to the beginning.
