



Beginning at a dead Bur Oak and and two Post Oaks, corner to Jesse McKay's Survey No. 5891, running with his line N. 30 W. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks in McKay's line N. 17 E. 300 poles binding on and running with the line of William Creighton Jurs. Entry No. 7261 to a Bur Oak, his Northeast corner in the lower line of Benjamin Stubblefield's Survey No. 5205; thence with Stubblefield's line East 37 poles to a Bur Oak, Southeast corner to Stubblefield's Survey; thence South 225 poles to six Bur Oaks, Southwest corner to the Representatives of Thomas Hill's Entry No. 8038; thence East 170 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak; thence S. 45 E. 100 poles to a forked Bur Oak in the edge of a prairie; thence S. 45 W. 250 poles to three Bur Oaks, Easterly corner to said McKay's Survey; thence with his line N. 47 W. 230 poles to the beginning.
