


Surveyed for John A. Fulton, assee. 800 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6129 on the waters of Paint Creek and Deer creek.

Beginning at two Black Oaks, Northeasterly corner to William Washington and Charles A. Stewart's Survey No. 7184, 6140 & 6063; thence North 400 poles passing their Southeast corner of Washington's Survey No. 6061 to two Elms in said Washington's line and in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4514; thence with their line East 22 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 78 E. 130 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to John Moore's Entry No. 5671; thence South 104 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, Southwest corner to said Moore; thence N. 78 E. 130 poles to a Stake in the line of Peter Muhlenberg's Survey No. 4915; thence with his line S. 14 E. 175 poles to a Stake, Southwest corner to Muhlenburg; thence South 120 poles to a Stake, Southwest corner to Entry No.

6053; thence East 160 poles to a Stake; thence S. 13 E. 25 poles to a Bur Oak, Northwest corner to William Robinson's Entry No. 6051; thence South 150 poles to a Stake, Northeast corner to John Shearer's Survey No. 5552 and 5676; thence West 20 poles to four Bur Oaks in Shearer's line; thence North 50 poles to a Stake; thence West 100 poles to three Bur Oaks, two from one root; thence South 50 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence West 100 poles to two Hickories; thence North 42 poles to a Black Oak; thence West 70 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak; thence North 75 poles to two Hickories; thence West 100 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Samuel Lapsley 510 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 387, on the waters of the Little Miami. Beginning at a White Oak and Black Oak, Northerly corner to John Stoke's Survey No. 1330; thence S. 35 E. 453 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence N. 27½ E. 114 poles to three Hickories, West corner to Galloway and Russell's Survey No. 6597; thence N. 39 E. 136 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence N. 41 W. 364 poles to a Stake; thence S. 55 W. 193 poles to the beginning.
