


Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 240 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 17 acres on No. 6125 and 223 acres on No. 6089 on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, lower back corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 5125; thence with his line N. 35 W. 66 poles to two Black Oaks and a Bur Oak, corner to Galloway's said Survey; thence with another of his lines, N. 10 W. 146 poles to a Bur Oak and Black Oak in said line, Easterly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 7064; thence with the line of said Survey S. 15 W. 42 poles to two Bur Oaks, Southeasterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 82 W. 181 poles with another line of said Survey to a Stake in said line, corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7929; thence with said line South 70 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Easterly corner to said Graham's Survey No. 7387 and Northerly corner to Johnston and Graham's Survey No. 7432 and 7756; thence with their line S. 63 E. 51 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie, Easterly corner to said Survey; thence with another of their lines S. 27 W. 121 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence S. 81 E. 26 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, Northwesterly corner to Dun and Johnston's Survey No. 7243; thence with their line N. 87 E. 92 poles to three Bur Oaks two of them from one root, Northerly corner to Survey No. 7243; thence with another line of said Survey N. 76 E. 132 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence N. 39 W. 33 poles to three Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to James Johnston's Survey No. 7823; thence with his line N. 67 E. 55 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for Conrad Kremer, assee. 200 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 6040 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at three White Oaks, Northeasterly corner to Samuel Baskerville's Survey No. 6023; thence N. 70 E. 160 poles to a Stake in a field; thence South 250 poles to three White Oaks and a Hickory; thence West 146 poles to a White Oak and Hickory in the line of Baskerville's said Survey; thence with his line North 196 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Campbell, assee. 200 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 2274 on the waters of Sugar creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Northeast corner to Joseph Newman's Survey No. 1341; thence North 200 poles to two Hickories; thence West 160 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory; thence South 200 poles to a Bur Oak in a prairie; thence East 160 poles to the beginning.
