


Surveyed for James S. Markham, assee. 400 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 6151, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a White Oak, Southeasterly corner to John Beck's Survey No. 4125, in the Southerly line of the Representatives of Mathew Arbuckle's Survey No. 3900; thence with Beck's Survey S. 30 W. 123 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey and East corner to James Steele's Survey No. 3725; thence with Steele's Survey, S. 48 W. 160 poles to a Hickory and White Oak, Northerly corner to Richard Priddy's Survey No. 4481; thence with Priddy's Survey, S. 42 E. 200 poles to two White Oaks, Easterly corner to said Survey; thence S. 45 E. 240 poles to a Stake and two Hickories in the west line of Robert Mean's Entry No. 5639; thence with said line North 265 poles to a Hickory in the Southerly line of said Mean's Entry No. 5791; thence with said line N. 67 W. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to said Entry; thence with another line thereof S. 23 E. 44 poles to three Hickories in the Southerly line of George Hoffman's Survey No. 6244; thence with said line N. 67 W. 150 poles to four White Oaks, Easterly corner to said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey, N. 23 E. 154 poles to a White Oak, Northerly corner to said Survey; thence N. 67 W. 26 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for James L. Markham, assee. 400 acres of land on four Military Warrants No. 6033, 6049, 6032 and 6047 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a White Oak, North corner to David Stephenson's Survey No. 5592, in the line of Nathan Littler's Survey No. 5801; thence with said line N. 20 E. 268 poles crossing a branch at 220 poles to a Bur Oak, Easterly corner to said Survey in the line of William Royall's Survey No. 8374 & 8792; thence with said line S. 70 E. 18 poles to a White Oak and Bur Oak, Southeasterly corner to said Survey, in the line of Parrett and Thompson's Survey No. 3903; thence with said line S. 20° 30' E. 188 poles crossing the branch to two Hickories and a Black Oak, Southwesterly corner to said Survey and Northwesterly corner to Stephen Southall's Survey No. 553; thence with his line S. 26 E. 400 poles crossing a branch to a White Oak and Black Oak in said line, North corner to Ann Garnett's Survey No. 7976; thence with her line S. 20 W. 53 poles to a Black Oak, Hickory and Post Oak, Easterly corner to Stephen's said Survey; thence with his line, N. 45 W. 474 poles crossing the branch at 335 poles to the beginning.
