

 No. 8414. 368 acres.

Beginning at two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Northerly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 6654; thence with his line N. 80 E. 46 poles to a Bur Oak in said line; thence N. 45 E. 185 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 52 W. 112 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root; thence S. 43 W. 168 poles to a Hickory; thence N. 15 W. 107 poles to three Hickories; thence S. 75 W. 148 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 15 E. 107 poles to three Hickories; thence N. 75 E. 112 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 39° 30' E. 95 poles to the beginning.
