


Surveyed for Anthony Walke, Nathan Haines, assees. and Edward Carrington, John Marshall; Harry Hith and Henry G. Hith, Executors of William Hith, dec'd, 500 acres of land on part of three Military Warrants, Walke, 309 acres on No. 6050, Haines 21 acres on No. 6016 and Hith's Executors 170 acres on No. 5852 on Treacles creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Southeasterly corner to Absolon Bainbridge's Survey No. 4805; thence with his line N. 6 E. 10 poles crossing the Creek to an Elm, Sycamore and Red Bud, on the bank of the creek, upper corner on the creek to Simon M. Stockdale's Survey No. 4808; thence down the creek on the upper side thereof and binding thereon, N. 61 E. 44 poles, N. 84 E. 10 poles, N. 23 E. 15 poles, S. 40 E. 24 poles, N. 87 E. 16½ poles, N. 32 E. 22 poles, S. 74 E. 28 poles, S. 60 E. 39 poles, N. 48 E. 42 poles to a Stake on the bank of the creek, N. 17° 30' W. and 4 poles distant from two Jack Oaks and a Red Elm, marked as a corner on the opposite bank of the creek; thence S. 17° 30' E. 56 poles crossing the creek at the corner to a stake in a prairie, upper back corner on the lower side of the creek to Joseph Swearingen's Survey No. 4870, 4945 & 5207; thence with his line S. 25 W. 180 poles to a White Oak, Westerly corner to Swaringen's and corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7465; thence with his line West 66 poles to a Stake in a prairie and two Bur Oaks from one root, corner to Graham's said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 17 E. 98 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line; thence S. 73 W. 222 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 17 W. 148 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southeasterly corner to Benjamin Hough's Survey No. 7472 & 7677; thence with Hough's line N. 24 E. 208 poles to three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root, Northeasterly corner to Hough's said Survey in the line of Bainbridge's said Survey; thence with said line S. 84 E. 80 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Gross Scruggs assee, James Johnston and Walter Dun, assees. 640 acres of land on part of three Military Warrants, Scruggs 400 acres on No. 5916, Johnston 190 acres on No. 5792 and Dun 50 acres on No. 6089, on the waters of Treacle's

Creek. Beginning at a Stake in a prairie, Southeasterly corner to Benjamin Hough's Survey No. 7472 & 7677; thence with his line N. 84 W. 180 poles to a Stake, Westerly corner to Hough in the line of John Graham and others Survey No. 7474; thence with said line S. 51 W. 111 poles to three Bur Oaks, two of them forked a southerly corner to Graham and others said Survey; thence S. 33 E. 164 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence S. 60 E. 367 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 29 E. 267 poles to two Bur Oaks, one of them forked, corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7465; thence with a line of Graham's said Survey, N. 17 W. 64 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line, Southwesterly corner to Anthony Walke and others Survey No. 8415 of 500 acres; thence with their line S. 73 W. 222 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Southerly corner to their said Survey; thence with another of their lines N. 17 W. 148 poles to the beginning.
