



Surveyed for John Graham, Walter Dun and Gross Scruggs Assees. 721 acres of land on part of seven Military Warrants, Graham 60 acres on No. 5787, 54 acres on No. 5784, 7 acres on No. 5832, 46 acres on No. 5786, 131 acres on No. 5791, Dun 260 acres on No. 6126 and Scruggs 163 acres on No. 5916, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at a forked White Oak, Easterly corner to William Croghan's Survey No. 6297; thence S. 38 E. 218 poles crossing a branch at 64, one at 104 one at 144, one at 156 and one at 174 poles to a large Bur Oak; thence S. 65 W. 118 poles crossing a branch at 94 poles to two White Oaks from one root; thence S. 84 W. 216 poles to three Hickories; thence N. 79 W. 142 poles to a Black Oak; thence S. 61 W. 49 poles to five Elms, Northerly corner to Benjamin Green's Survey No. 6285; thence with Green's line West 115 poles to a Stake in said line; thence N. 51 W. 134 poles crossing a branch at 54 poles to a Hickory and Black Oak; thence N. 60 E. 102 poles to two Elms and a Bur Oak, Southwesterly corner to said Croghan's Survey; thence N. 52 E. 104 poles crossing a branch at 84 poles to an Elm and Bur Oak, corner to Croghan's Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 80 E. 110 poles to two White Oaks, one of them forked, corner to Croghan's said Survey; thence with another line of said Survey East 180 poles crossing a branch at 40 poles and one at 150 poles to four White Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 76 E. 130 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 138 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, 18 acres on No. 6079 and 120 acres on No. 6217, on the waters of Treacle's creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak and Hickory, Southeast corner to John Erwin's Survey No. 7676, in the line of Levi Springer's Survey No. 7946; thence with said line S. 35 E. 234 poles to three Bur Oaks in said line; thence N. 55 E. 7 poles to three Bur Oaks, Westerly corner to Dun and others Survey No. 8854; thence with their line, N. 30 E. 60 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, corner to their Survey; thence with another of their lines N. 9 E. 164 poles to four Bur Oaks, corner to their said Survey, and corner to George Hover's Survey No. 8135; thence with Hover's line S. 47 W. 68 poles to a Stake in a large prairie, Southerly corner to Hovers said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 35 W. 103 poles to a Stake, Westerly corner to Hovers said Survey in the line of Erwin's said Survey; thence with said line S. 55 W. 110 poles to the beginning.
