


Surveyed for William Robinson, assee. 335 acres of land on part of four Military Warrants 50 acres on No. 6157, 100 acres on No. 5494, 100 acres on No. 5744 and 85 acres on No. 5978, on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to Samuel Baskerville's Survey No. 5526, and Northwest corner to Conrad Kremer's Survey No. 8326; thence with Kremer's line N. 70 E. 160 poles to a Stake in a field Northeast corner to said Survey; thence South 56 poles to a Stake; thence East 40 poles to a Stake; thence N. 12 W. 285 poles to a Red Oak, Hickory and White Oak, West corner to Levi Springer's Survey No. 7945 & 8448, in the line of Thomas Worthington's Survey No. 8922; thence with said line S. 75 W. 92 poles to an Elm and Bur Oak, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence N. 15 W. 66 poles to a Stake, East corner Chiltons and Stephenson's Survey No. 5795; thence with their line S. 18 W. 210 poles to two Bur Oaks and a Hickory, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence West 80 poles to a Stake in the line of John Shearer's Survey No. 5526; thence South 115 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to Baskerville's said Survey; thence East 118 poles to the beginning.




to three Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence N. 17 E. 94 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 73 E. 88 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of said Galloway's Survey No. 6653; thence with said line S. 23 W. 94 poles to the beginning.

200 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 35 W. 80 poles to a Stake; thence N. 55 E. 200 poles to the beginning.
