


Surveyed for Walter Dun and David Chapman, assees.

458-1/3 acres of land on part of five Military Warrants, Dun 100 acres on No. 5870 and Chapman 100 acres on No. 6417, 58-1/3 acres on No. 6489, 20 acres on No. 6428 and 180 acres on No. 6428, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Southeasterly corner to James Johnston's Survey No. 7239; thence with his line, S. 74 W. 142 poles passing his Southwesterly corner at 114 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence South 146 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence West 30 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence South 34 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence East 63 poles passing the Northwesterly corner of said Johnston's Survey No. 7394 and with his line to three Bur Oaks, one of his North-erly corners; thence with another of his lines S. 71 E. 112 poles to a Hickory and Small Bur Oak, Westerly corner to said Dun's Survey No. 7752; thence N. 11 E. 75 poles to two Bur Oaks, Northwesterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 85 E. 114 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 35 W. 30 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 44 E. 38 poles to a Stake in a prairie in the line of said Survey; thence with said line N. 64 E. 64 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 80 E. 64 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line; thence North 138 poles to two Bur Oaks, in the line of John Evans Survey No. 10469; thence N. 80 W. 140 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 7 E. 81 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence S. 71 W. 46 poles to a forked Bur Oak in the edge of a prairie, Southerly corner to Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7757; thence N. 65 W. 100 poles to a Bur Oak, Southwesterly corner to said Survey in the line of Johnston's said Survey; thence with said line South 64 poles to the beginning.

Beginning at a Stake, Northwest corner of Henry Brush's Survey No. 7279, and in the line of the Reps. of William Sanford's Survey No. 6052 & 9803; thence with the line of Brush's said Survey, South 120 poles to a Stake, Southwest corner of said Survey and in the line of Nathan Litler's Entry No. 5803; thence with the line of said Entry West 36 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner of said Entry; thence with another line of said Entry, South 35 poles to a Stake in the North line of Jesse Dungan's Survey No. 6267; thence with said line West 76 poles to a Post Oak and Hickory, Northwest corner to said Survey and corner to said Survey No. 6052 & 9803; thence with the line of said Survey N. 36 E. 190 poles to the beginning.
