





corner to James Johnson's Survey No. 7636; thence binding on said Survey, S. 65 E. 45 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 30 E. 44 poles to a Stake; S. 35 W. 114 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak, South corner to Johnston; thence S. 50 E. 59 poles to two White Oaks; thence N. 60 E. 140 poles to a Stake in a prairie; thence N. 4 W. 130 poles to three Hickories; thence N. 16 W. 64 poles to an Elm; thence N. 55 W. 164 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 89 W. 2 poles to a Stake; thence S. 1 E. 161 poles to the beginning.
