


Surveyed for Mary and Mills Reddick 250 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5921 on the waters of Deer and Treacles Creek. Beginning at a Stake, Easterly corner to Lincoln Goodale's Survey No. 6644 in the line of James Galloway's Survey No. 6652, running with Galloway's line and corner thereof N. 17 E. 402 poles to a Stake in the line of said Galloway's Survey No. 6971; thence with said line N. 50 W. 119 poles to a White Oak, upper back corner to said Survey; thence S. 17 W. 95 poles to a Stake in the line of William Ewing's Survey No. 8084; thence with his line S. 68 E. 24 poles to a Stake in a prairie, Northeasterly corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 22 W. 160 poles to three Bur Oaks, Southeasterly corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 68 W. 9 poles to a Stake; thence S. 17 W. 164 poles to a Stake in the line of said Goodale's Survey; thence with his line S. 60 E. 106 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Campbell assee. 235 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 2274 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at a White Oak, Westerly corner to George Handy's Survey No. 9437, in the line of Thomas Bell's Survey No. 462; thence with said line N. 56 W. 103 poles crossing a branch to a White Oak and Hickory, corner to Robert Mean's Survey No. 10625; thence with his line N. 34 E. 84 poles crossing a branch at 15 poles to three



Hickories, East corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof N. 56 W. 130 poles crossing the branch at 28 poles to two Black Oaks and a Hickory, in the South line of Tarlton Woodson's Survey No. 8800; thence with said line and the line of Joseph Hite's Survey No. 9270, E. 375 poles to three White Oaks, Northwesterly corner to said Hite's Survey No. 9269; thence with Hite's line S. 30 W.

51 poles to a small White Oak in the North line of Elias T. Langham's Entry No. 9207; thence with said line West 28 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to said Entry; thence with another line of said Entry, South 50 poles to two Jack Oaks, Southwesterly corner of said Entry and corner to said Hite's Survey No. 9269; thence S. 71 W. 150 poles to a White Oak, Northerly corner to Handy's said Survey; thence with his line S. 34 W. 66 poles to the beginning.
