


Surveyed for Nathaniel Sawyer's 120 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6380 on the waters of Glady run of the Spring fork of Treacles Creek. Beginning at a Stake in a prairie, Easterly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 11020 & 12009; 7 poles N. 50 W. from a forked Bur Oak and Black Oak, Westerly corner to John Crawford's No. 6201; thence S. 50 E. 86 poles to two White Oaks; thence S. 40 W. 137½ poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak, West corner to W. Dun's Survey No. 12172; thence S. 80 W. 200 poles to two Black Oaks in the line of Entry No. 11031; thence N. 37 E. 89½ poles to a Stake in the line of Galloway's aafs'd. Survey; thence binding on said Survey S. 50 E. 47½ poles to a Stake his Southerly corner; thence N. 40 E. 200 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for Mahlon Wilson 200 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 5908 on the waters of Darby Creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to Dun and Chapman's Survey No. 10081, 10605, 10984, 10858 & 12171 in the line of John Evans' Survey No. 10469; thence with the line of the first mentioned Survey South 123 poles to a Stake in the line of W. Dun's Survey No. 7752; thence binding on said Survey S. 80 E. 40 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence S. 73 E. 58 poles to a Stake in the line of John Graham's Survey No. 7386; thence binding on his Survey N. 49 E. 61 poles to a Bur Oak; thence East 90 poles to two White Oaks, in the line of Moore No. 6508; thence N. 20 E. 33 poles to two White Oaks and Elm; thence N. 74 E. 54 poles to a Hickory, Red Oak and Bur Oak, South corner to Johnston No. 7395; thence with his line N. 70 W. 75 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 57½ W. 136 poles to a Stake in the line of John Evans' Survey No. 10469; thence binding on said Survey S. 6 W. 73 poles to a Stake his Southeast corner; thence S. 80 W. 87 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Moore, 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5160 on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at a Stake most Westerly corner to Peter Muhlenberg's Survey No. 8745; thence with his line N. 78 E. 30 poles to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence with another line thereof North 103 poles to three Bur Oaks and a Hickory in said line, Southeast corner to the Representatives of Peter Helphinstine's Survey No. 4514; thence with their line S. 78 W. 160 poles to a Stake in said line; thence South 103 poles crossing a branch to a Bur Oak and Hickory; thence N. 78 E. 130 poles crossing a branch to the beginning.
