

Surveyed for Nathaniel Sawyer, William Woolfolk, Mary Stephenson and Joseph Pugh, 3300 acres of land on part of three Military Warrants, Sawyer 2000 acres on No. 6512, Woolfolk 600 acres on No. 6474, Stephenson 400 acres on No. 6440 and Pugh 300 acres on No. 6376, between the Spring fork and Treacle's Creek. Beginning at a White Oak, Southwest corner to Thomas M. Bayly's Survey No. 5609; thence with the line of Survey No. 10928, S. 60 W. 86 poles to a White Oak and Bur Oak; thence with the line of Survey No. 5747, S. 82 W. 106 poles to two Black Oaks, South corner to Survey No. 7473; thence with the line of said Survey N. 25 E. 111 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak; thence N. 38 W. 131 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 22 W. 28 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 17 W. 76 poles to a Jack Oak and White Oak; thence N. 54 W. 62 poles to three Bur Oaks in the edge of a prairie; thence N. $63\frac{1}{2}$ W. 81 poles to two Hickories and a White Oak, Northerly corner to said Survey; thence N. $75\frac{1}{2}$ E. 40 poles to three Hickories, corner to Survey No. 7529; thence N. $17\frac{1}{2}$ W. 161 poles to a White Oak and Hickory; thence S. 62 W. 115 poles to a Red Oak and Large Bur Oak in the line of No. 5481; thence N. 10 E. 80 poles to three White Oaks, South corner to Survey No. 5482; thence with the line of said Survey N. 15 E. 69 poles to a large Bur Oak; thence N. 7 W. 83 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory; N. 36 W. 61 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root, corner Simon
