


Surveyed for George Clark, assee. 110 acres of land on part of three Military Warrants 38 acres on No. 5513, 10 acres on No. 5597 and 62 acres on No. 5514, on the waters of Treacles Creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and an Elm, Most Westerly corner to John Baird's Survey No. 5263; thence with his line S. 20 E. 54 poles to two White Oaks in said line, an Easterly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 5747; thence S. 73° 30' W. 70 poles to two Hickories and an Elm, corner to Galloway; thence N. 18 W. 110 poles to two White Oaks corner to said Survey; thence N. 68 E. 30 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence N. 50 W. 104 poles to a White Oak and Bur Oak, corner to said Survey; thence N. 60 E. 105 poles to a White Oak, lower back corner to Thomas M. Bayly's Survey No. 5606; thence with his line N. 70 E. 53 poles to a White Oak in said line, upper back corner to Baird's said Survey; thence with his line S. 3 W. 184 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for John Yarborough and William Withers 200 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Yarborough 125 acres on No. 6459 and Withers 75 acres on No. 6539, on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at two White Oaks and a Hickory, Southwest corner to James Innis' Survey No. 2692; thence N. 20 E. 58 poles to a Stake, Southeast corner to Elias Langham's Survey No. 6517; thence with Langham's lines S. 70 W. 96 poles to two Hickories, Southwest corner to said Survey; thence N. 20 E. 222 poles, crossing a branch at 77, Turkey run at 136 and the road from Chillicothe to London at 162 poles to a Stake, Northwest corner to said Survey in the line of Uriah Springer's Survey No. 1020; thence with said line N. 70 W. 98 poles to a Stake, East corner to Beverly Stubblefield's Survey No. 5423; thence with Stubblefield's line West 50 poles to a Stake in said line, Northeast corner to Levi Springer's Survey No. 8118; thence with Springer's line South 330 poles crossing the road and run to three Bur Oaks, Southeast corner to said Survey; thence East 142 poles to the beginning.

Forsman, assee. 63½ acres of land on part of two Military Warrants, Galloway 56 acres on No. 5065 and Forsman 7½ acres on No. 6463, on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks from one root, a Westerly corner to said Galloway's Survey No. 7404, running S. 37½ W. 121 poles to a Black Oak, Ash and White Oak, corner to said Survey and corner to the Representatives of Nicholas Hobson's Survey No. 6350; thence with Galloway's line S. 55 E. 80 poles to a Stake corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 45 E. 120 poles to a Stake, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, N. 53 W. 95 poles to the beginning.
