



Surveyed for John Beck 250 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 852 on the waters of Deer Creek and Darby's Creek. Beginning at four Bur Oaks, Southerly corner to Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7812; thence N. 54 E. 126 poles to a Hickory and Bur Oak, corner to James McAboy's Entry No. 10430; thence N. $86\frac{1}{2}$ E. $66\frac{1}{2}$ poles to two Bur Oaks, Northwest corner to said Scrugg's Survey No. 7813; thence with his line S. 10 E. 104 poles to a Bur Oak and two Hickories; thence N. 75 E. 109 poles to two Bur Oaks, Southwesterly corner to Graham's Survey No. 7928; thence S. 77 E. 90 poles to two Hickories, Southeasterly corner to said Survey; thence S. 9 W. 85 poles to three Bur Oaks, corner to Survey No. 8081; thence S. 65 W. 111 poles to two Hickories, corner to said Survey; thence N. $77\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60 poles to a Bur Oak, corner to Survey No. 1082; thence with the line of said Survey N. 73 W. 168 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 23 W. 96 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Thomas Green, assee. 200 acres of land on two Military Warrants No. 6509 and 6510, on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Northerly corner to Walter Dun's Survey No. 8484 and corner to No. 7774 and 7775; thence with lines of No. 7775, S. 79 E. 127 poles to a Bur Oak in the edge of a prairie; thence N. $85^{\circ} 45'$ E. 118 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence N. 89 E. 73 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root, in the line of No. 7753; thence with said lines S. 43 W. 43 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 10 W. 102 poles to three Bur Oaks; thence S. 4 W. 48 poles to three Bur Oaks, two from one root, Southwest corner to No. 7753; thence N. $83\frac{1}{2}$ W. 91 poles to a Stake in the line of No. 8484; thence with the lines of said Survey N. 6 E. 19 poles to a Stake; thence N. 70 W. 118 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 4 E. 74 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 56 W. 88 poles to the beginning.
