





Beginning at two hackberries on the bank of the Creek, on the lower side, running up the creek with the meanders thereof, N. 28 E. 28, N. 6 E. 30, N. 25 W. 40, North 52, N. 38 W. 36, N. 60 W. 36, N. 39 W. 66 poles to a red oak and five ironwoods, on the north bank of the Creek; thence S. 67 W. 93 poles to an elm; thence S. 23 E. 260 poles to an elm and hickory; thence N. 67 E. 93 poles to the beginning.
