


Surveyed for Robert Dun, assee. 130 acres of land on a Military Warrant No. 6072, and 30 acres on part of No. 6079, on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at two Thorns and an Elm, Southeast corner to the Representatives of James Winkfield's Survey No. 4573 and Southwesterly corner to James Galloway's Survey No. 7070; thence with Galloway's line East 125 poles to two Jack Oaks and a Hickory in said line; thence South 167 poles crossing a branch at 157 poles to a Hickory in the line of the Representatives of William Carter's Survey No. 5874; thence with said line West 125 poles to two Elms and a small Jack Oak, in said line; thence North 167 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 120 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6089 on the waters of Darby's Creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak in a prairie, Southeasterly corner to Rice Haggard's Survey No. 7057 in the line of James Galloway's Survey No. 7070; thence with Galloway's line East 156 poles crossing a branch at 74 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak in said line; thence N. 64 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root; thence N. 65 E. 59 poles crossing the branch at two Bur Oaks on the West side of a Road; thence North 29 poles to a Bur Oak; thence N. 85 W. 44 poles to two White Oak, Easterly corner to John Moore's Survey No. 6508; thence with said line West 144 poles to two White Oaks, corner to Moore's said Survey and Northerly corner to Haggard's said Survey; thence with Haggard's line S. 10 W. 124 poles to the beginning.



Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 70 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5547 on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacle's creek. Beginning at a Hickory and Bur Oak, S. 5 W. 98 poles from the Northwesterly corner of the Representatives of John Case's Survey No. 5482; thence S. 5 W. 92 poles crossing a branch at 34, and one at 80 poles to three White Oaks; thence S. 80 W. 20 poles to two White Oaks from one root; thence S. 9 E. 26 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 78 W. 62 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 40 W. 34 poles to two Bur Oaks from one root in a prairie; thence N. 15 W. 46 poles to a Bur Oak and White Oak; thence N. 20 E. 49 poles to two White Oaks and a Hickory; thence N. 81 E. 103 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 80 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6119 on the waters of Deer Creek. Beginning at four Bur Oaks, Northeast-erly corner to James Johnston's Survey No. 7241 and corner to Gross Scrugg's Survey No. 7759; thence with Johnston's line N. 75 W. 47 poles to a Stake in said line; thence N. 5 W. 199 poles to a Stake; thence N. 85 E. 80 poles to a Stake; thence S. 5 E. 131 poles to a Stake in a prairie, in the line of Scrugg's said Survey; thence with said line S. 60 W. 68 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root, Northwesterly corner to Scrugg's said Survey; thence with another of his lines, S. 30 E. 61 poles to the beginning.
