


Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 165 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6098 on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Bur Oaks, an Easterly corner to said Dun's Survey No. 8439; thence with his line, North 3 poles to a Bur Oak in the line of John Graham's Survey No. 7832; thence with Graham's line branch at 54 and a S. 58 E. 237 poles crossing a large branch at 223 poles to a forked Jack Oak, Southerly corner to Graham's said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 46 E. 62 poles crossing a branch at 13 poles to a Hickory and forked White Oak corner to Graham; thence with another of his lines N. 5 E. 42 poles to a small Bur Oak in a prairie corner to Graham; thence with another of his lines N. 65 E. 48 poles to a White Oak in a prairie, corner to Graham's said Survey; thence S. 6 W. 17 poles to a Stake in the line of James Galloway's Survey No. 7062; thence with said line West 12 poles to three small Black Oaks, Westerly corner to Galloway's said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 5 E. 86 poles crossing a branch to two Bur Oaks, Southwesterly corner to Galloway's said Survey in the line of Lucas Sullivant's Survey No. 3313; thence with said line N. 78 W. 14 poles to a large White Oak, upper back corner to Sullivant's said Survey; thence with another of his lines S. 12 W. 108 poles crossing a branch at 88 poles to three Jack Oak Saplings in said line; thence N. 61 W. 159 poles crossing a branch at 27 a drain at 120 and one at 132 poles to a White Oak; thence N. 44° 30' W. 84 poles to two Hickories and a Black Oak; thence S. 89 W. 102 poles to two Hickories and a Bur Oak, Southeasterly corner to Dun's said Survey; thence North 64 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root, corner to Dun; thence with another of his lines, N. 65 E. 59 poles crossing the large branch to the beginning.

Surveyed for Walter Duh, assee. 104 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6098, on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at two Hickories from one root and a Bur Oak, Northerly corner to said Dun's Survey No. 8417; thence with his line South 90 poles crossing a branch to a Stake in a prairie, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines, East 66 poles crossing a branch to two Bur Oaks, corner to said Survey; thence with another of his lines South 80 poles crossing a branch at 12 and one at 16 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line; thence N. 72 E. 75 poles to a Bur Oak on the edge of a prairie; thence North 150 poles crossing a branch at 12 poles to a Bur Oak and Stake; thence West 138 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Jacob Vandeventer, assee. 50 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5985 on the waters of Paint creek. Beginning at three Post White Oaks in the edge of a prairie, Northwest corner to Josiah Cornelius' Survey No. 3984, Northeast corner to Miles Jennings' Survey No. 540 and Southeast corner to John Redwood's Survey No. 540, running with said Redwood's line and course thereof North 160 poles to three Hickories; thence East 50 poles to three Bur Oaks, two of them from one root; thence South 160 poles to a Stake; thence West 50 poles to the beginning.
