


Surveyed for Walter Dun, assee. 90 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5718 on the waters of Darby's creek. Beginning at a Stake in a prairie, Southwest corner to John Graham's Survey No. 7390 and Southeasterly corner to said Dun's Survey No. 7751 and 7774; thence with Graham's line East 77 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line, corner to Scruggs and Graham's Survey No. 7758 and 7830; thence with their line South 63 poles to two Bur Oaks their Southwesterly corner; thence S. 50 W. 64 poles to four Bur Oaks from one root, one of them forked, Northerly corner to said Dun's Survey No. 7753; thence with Dun's line S. 75 W. 51 poles to a Bur Oak corner to Dun's said Survey; thence with another of his lines N. 85 W. 103 poles to a Stake in a prairie in said line, corner to Dun's said Survey No. 7751 & 7774; thence with his line N. 8 E. 32 poles to a Stake, corner to said Dun's last mentioned Survey; thence with another line thereof N. 60 E. 141 poles to the beginning.




Surveyed for John A. Fulton, assee. 253 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants 200 acres on No. 6130 and 53 acres on No. 6158 on the North fork of Paint creek. Beginning at two Hickories and a White Oak, Northeast corner to John Haine's Survey No. 4408; thence North 280 poles to two Bur Oaks; thence N. 79 W. 120 poles crossing a small branch to two Hickories from one root; thence S. 20 W. 82 poles to a Bur Oak; thence S. 1 W. 230 poles crossing the North fork to five White Oaks and a Hickory, Northwest corner to Haine's said Survey; thence E. 152 poles crossing the fork to the beginning.

Surveyed for Peter Muhlenberg 410 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 176, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at an Elm, Hickory and Bur Oak, Southeasterly corner to Sigismund Stribling's Survey No. 5802 in the line of David Stephenson's Survey No. 5592; thence S. 20 W. 352 poles to a Red Oak, White Oak and Elm, South corner to said Stribling in the line of Charles Buck's Survey No. 4540; thence S. 70 E. 164 poles to a White Oak and Hickory, Easterly corner to said Buck; thence S. 20 W. 47 poles to two Bur Oaks and an Elm, Northerly corner to William Geddy's Survey No. 4510; thence with Geddy's line S. 72° 39' E. 110 poles to a Stake in a line thereof; thence N. 20 E. 157 poles crossing a branch to a Stake in the line of Ann Garnett's Survey No. 7976; thence N. 70 W. 110 poles to a Pin Oak and Hickory, corner to said Survey; thence N. 20 E. 167 poles to two Hickories, corner to said Survey; thence N. 45 W. 183 poles passing the South corner of Stephenson's said Survey at 16½ poles, to the beginning.
