


Surveyed for Peter Muhlenberg 850 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 176 on Walnut Run a branch of Oak run, a branch of Deer creek. Beginning at a Bur Oak marked S.W. R. H. and a Hickory, Southeast corner to the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4514; thence South 104 poles to a Stake in a prairie from which a Hickory cornered and marked I. H. bears S. 73 W. 2 poles; thence S. 78 W. 30 poles to a Stake; thence S. 14 E. 370 poles crossing the West branch at 124, 132 and 149 poles to a Stake in the barrons; thence East 109 poles to a Bur Oak and Hickory, Southwest corner to said Helphenstine's Survey No. 4387 of 1158 acres; thence North 600 poles crossing the run at 100 poles to two large White Oaks, Northwest corner to said Survey and Southwest corner to their Survey No. 4513; thence with the line of the last mentioned Survey N. 16° 30' W. 397 poles to a Stake in said line; thence West 55 poles to three Bur Oaks from one root, Northeast corner to the first mentioned Survey; thence South 410 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for the heirs of Nicholas Hobson, decd. 440 acres of land on part of two Military Warrants 370 acres on No. 5715 and 70 acres on No. 5716, on the waters of Deer creek. Beginning at three White Oaks and three Hickories, East corner to

Chilton and Stephenson's Survey No. 5795; thence N. 9 W. 160 poles to three White Oaks, Northeasterly corner to said Survey in the line of the Representatives of Peter Helphenstine's Survey No. 4387; thence with said line East 95 poles to three Hickories

Southeasterly corner to said Survey; thence N. 19½ E. 212 poles to a Black Oak, corner to said Survey; thence South 108 poles to a Black Oak and Hickory, Southwest corner to James Armstrong's Survey No. 6576; thence East 259 poles to two Hickories from one root, Northwest corner to Elias Barcroft's Survey No. 6456; thence with his line South 149 poles to a Stake; thence S. 75 W. 414 poles to the beginning.
