

Beginning at a Post Oak, Southeast corner to Benjamin Stubblefield's Survey No. 5205; thence South 259 poles to six Bur Oaks corner to John A. Fulton's Survey No. 8044; thence East 290 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence North 579 poles to a Stake in the barrens; thence West 290 poles to a Bur Oak, Northeast corner to said Stubblefield's said Survey; thence South 320 poles to the beginning.


Surveyed for Abraham Shepherd, assee. 75 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 6166 on the waters of the Spring fork of Treacle's creek. Beginning at three Bur Oaks, Northeasterly corner to Beverly Stubblefield's Survey No. 5435, in the line of Lincoln



Goodale's Survey No. 6645, running with Goodale's line and course thereof N. 60 E. 150 poles to three Hickories, Northeast corner to Thomas M. Bayly's Survey No. 5479; thence with his line and course thereof South 194 poles to a Stake in the line of said Stubblefield's Survey; thence with his line N. 47 W. 177 poles to the beginning.

Surveyed for Jacob Vandevanter, assee. 100 acres of land on part of a Military Warrant No. 5985 on Paint creek. Beginning at three Elms and a forked Black Walnut, Southeast corner to Miles Jennings's Survey No. 540, running with his line North 160 poles crossing the creek to two Bur Oaks, Northeast corner to his Survey; thence East 100 poles to a Stake; thence South 160 poles to four Bur Oaks; thence West 100 poles crossing the creek to the beginning.
